- To improve financial management and budget implementation flexibility, National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University Funding and Expenditure Standards for the Implementation of Businesses and Activities (hereinafter referred to as the "Standards") have been established according to Article 4 of the University's Guidelines for the Management of Self-Raised Funds and Expenditures.
- 2. Unless stipulated by law, the University's other regulations, or subsidization (commissioned) units' regulations, funding of various businesses and activities conducted by the University shall be handled in accordance with the Standards.
- 3. The funding and expenditure standards for implementing various businesses and activities are further described as follows:
